Baxter 2013-10-01 poet and performer sam hunt first became aware of the poems of james k baxter as a schoolboy aged 14 he was strapped for reciting baxter s poem evidence at the witch trials in an english lesson one of the final in a series of events resulting in his expulsion from college james k baxter later became a friend and mentor who greatly influenced the unconventional poetic course sam hunt s life would take here hunt offers a selection of 50 poems by baxter that have made an indelible impression on the grooves of his brain and tongue poems he has lived with road tested and recited around new zealand for more than 40 years hunt has included in the selection a range of the very familiar and the less familiar of baxter s poems dating from 1945 to 1972 in his substantial introduction hunt offers his memories of jim baxter and explains his selection james k baxter poems offers a fresh uniquely personal look at the work of baxter a rare insight into the creative relationship between two leading writers and reminds how crucial it is that we listen to our poets

The Rock Woman 1969 a landmark in new zealand literary scholarship this book provides an extraordinary insight into the formative years of one of new zealand s most significant poets included are 56 letters written by james k baxter to his slightly older friend noel ginn who was at the time imprisoned as a conscientious objector in these letters a teenage baxter pours out his ideas and feelings on life philosophy and his own work included are the complete texts of the 255 poems written at the time and discussed in the letters the introduction an important work of biographical criticism in its own right puts baxter s ideas and interests within the context of the wider public events and intellectual and spiritual currents of his time

New Selected Poems 2001 the poetry of james k baxter 1926 1972 has won wide acclaim first published in 1982 this selection of 200 poems from all periods of his writing has become the standard introduction to his work for the student and general reader the full range of his poetry is represented and the important sequences have been included in full the editor himself a poet and critic was also a close friend of james k baxter

Baxter 1971 james k baxter one of new zealand s greatest poets began writing poetry when he was a seven year old pupil at brighton primary school by the time his first book beyond the palisades was published when he was eighteen he had written more than 600 poems his life s work contained in this four volume set runs to just over 3000 poems more than half of which have never before been published john weir a fellow poet friend and confidant of baxter has achieved the herculean task of sorting these into a coherent order noting where poems have been reworked or repurposed their possible inspirations and influences and baxter s own thoughts about his work publisher s information

Baxter 2019 the story of a pivotal president who watched over our westward expansion and solidified the dream of jacksonian democracy james k polk was a shrewd and decisive commander in chief the youngest president elected to guide the still young nation who served as speaker of the house and governor of tennessee before taking office in 1845 considered a natural successor to andrew jackson young hickory miraculously revived his floundering political career by riding a wave of public sentiment in favor of annexing the republic of texas to the union shortly after his inauguration he settled the disputed oregon boundary and by 1846 had declared war on mexico in hopes of annexing california the considerably smaller american army never lost a battle at home however polk suffered a political firestorm of antiwar attacks from many fronts despite his tremendous accomplishments he left office an extremely unpopular man on whom stress had taken such a physical toll that he died within three months of departing washington fellow tennessean john seigenthaler traces the life of this president who as truman noted said what he intended to do and did it

The Holy Life and Death of Concrete Grady 1976 when he was elected president in 1845 james k polk was only 49 years old at that time the youngest president ever to be elected he faced a conflicted nation on the verge of tremendous territorial expansion p james k polk s four years in office marked the greatest period of territorial acquisition in the history of the country what new york journalist john o sullivan termed as the manifest destiny of the united states to expand across the continent by the end of polk s presidency in 1849 u s possessions included the california oregon and new mexico territories in addition texas had become part of the union p this book analyzes polk s political career and his role in each of these territorial expansions james k polk a clear and unquestionable destiny shows that they were far more complex than the moral crusade that had been labeled manifest destiny southern planters wanted to protect their peculiar institution of slavery by adding new territories from which slave states would be carved commercial interests feared that war with england over any of these territories would adversely impact upon the nation s trade although the oregon boundary dispute was settled with little friction the mexican war erupted after the annexation of texas p this fascinating biography of our eleventh president and his successful efforts for expansion of u s territory will be of interest to students studying united states history foreign policy and the massive territorial expansion in the 1840s known as manifest destiny p
